

NOTICE OF PROPOSED MAJOR UTILITY FACILITY

AEP Ohio representatives plan to build a substation off Perimeter Road, south of Piketon. Building the new substation allows crews to retire an existing substation and provide electric service to a customer. Company officials expect construction to begin May 2022 and conclude fall 2023.

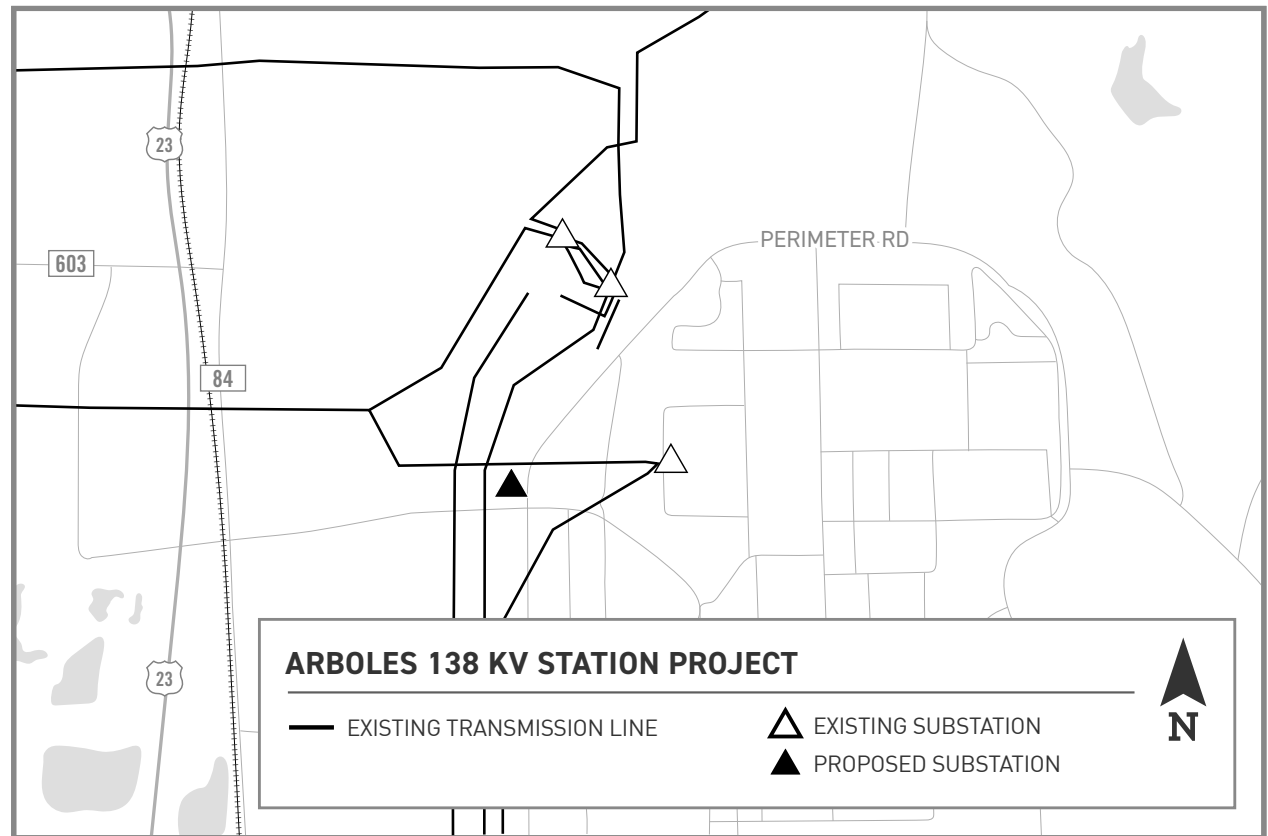
AEP Ohio representatives filed a Letter of Notification with the Ohio Power Siting Board (OPSB) for the project as the Arboles 138 kV Station Project, Case No. 21-1084-EL-ELN. The Letter of Notification to construct, operate and maintain this facility awaits OPSB review.

The OPSB accepts motions to intervene in the Letter of Notification up to 10 days following the publication date of this notice.

The requirements to intervene can be found in Rule 4906-2-12 of the Ohio Administrative Code.
