

Maliszewski-Corridor Transmission Line Reconductor Project

The Maliszewski-Corridor Transmission Line Reconductor Project focuses on upgrading and modernizing the local power grid to enhance service reliability in Franklin, Delaware and Union counties. The project involves replacing the wires, or reconductoring, on about 15 miles of 345-kilovolt (kV) transmission lines and upgrading two existing substations to enhance service reliability in the area. Crews plan to begin construction in early 2028 and conclude in summer 2029.

What

The Project involves:

- Reconductoring about 10 miles of 345-kV transmission line between Maliszewski Substation off Green Meadows Drive in Lewis Center and Corridor Substation off Harlem Road in Westerville (see Map 1 on next page).
- Reconductoring about 5 miles of 345-kV transmission line in York Township, Union County (see Map 2 on next page).
- Upgrading and expanding the existing Maliszewski and Corridor substations.
- Reconfiguring transmission lines entering and exiting Maliszewski and Corridor substations.

*This project requires regulatory approval from the Ohio Power Siting Board (OPSB)

Why

The planned improvements will:

- Upgrade the local power grid to meet modern standards and ensure the continued safe operation and maintenance of the power line.
- Allow for an increased flow of high-voltage electricity that will boost capacity in the region.

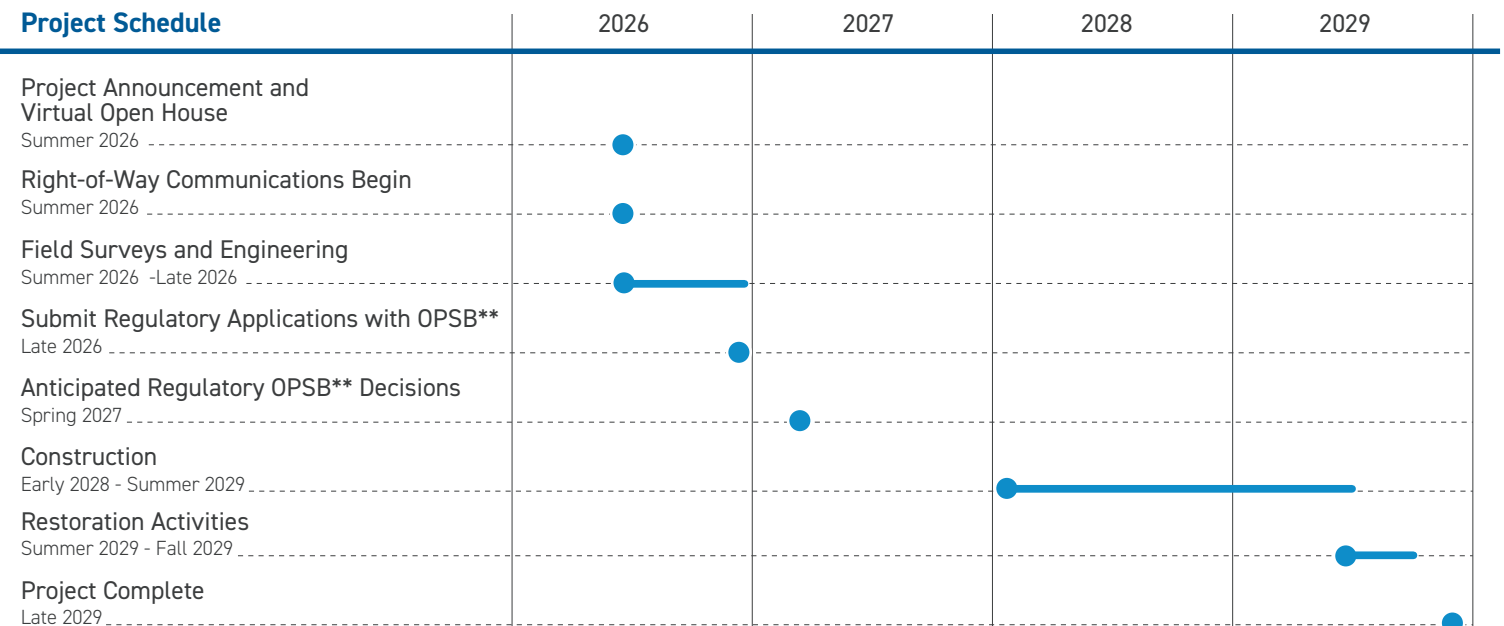
Where

The project area includes:

- Genoa and Orange townships in Delaware County
- Blendon Township in Franklin County
- York Township in Union County
- City of Westerville

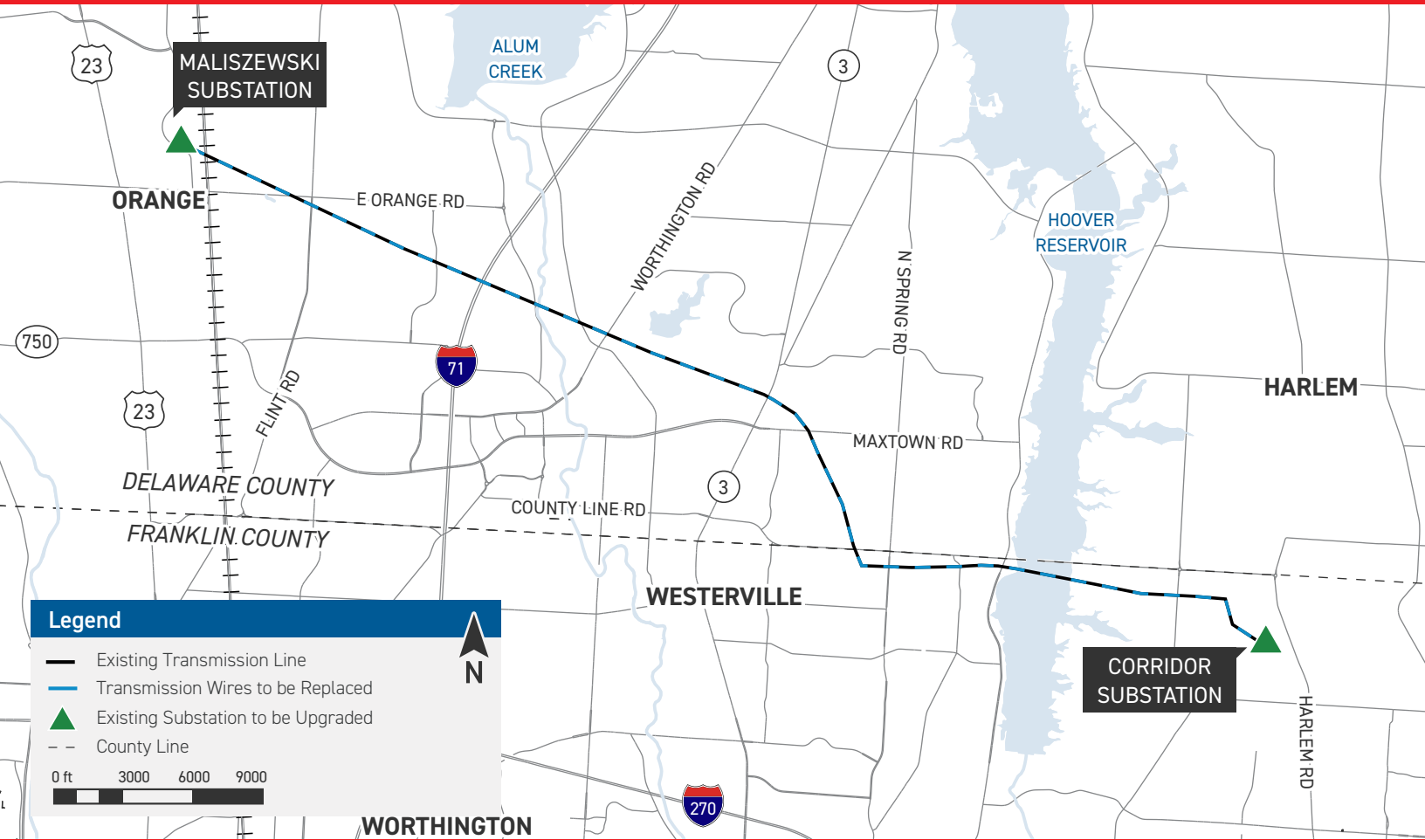
Plans call for reconductoring the power line in the existing right-of-way, although existing easements may need to be updated to ensure the safe construction, operation and maintenance of the line.

Project Schedule

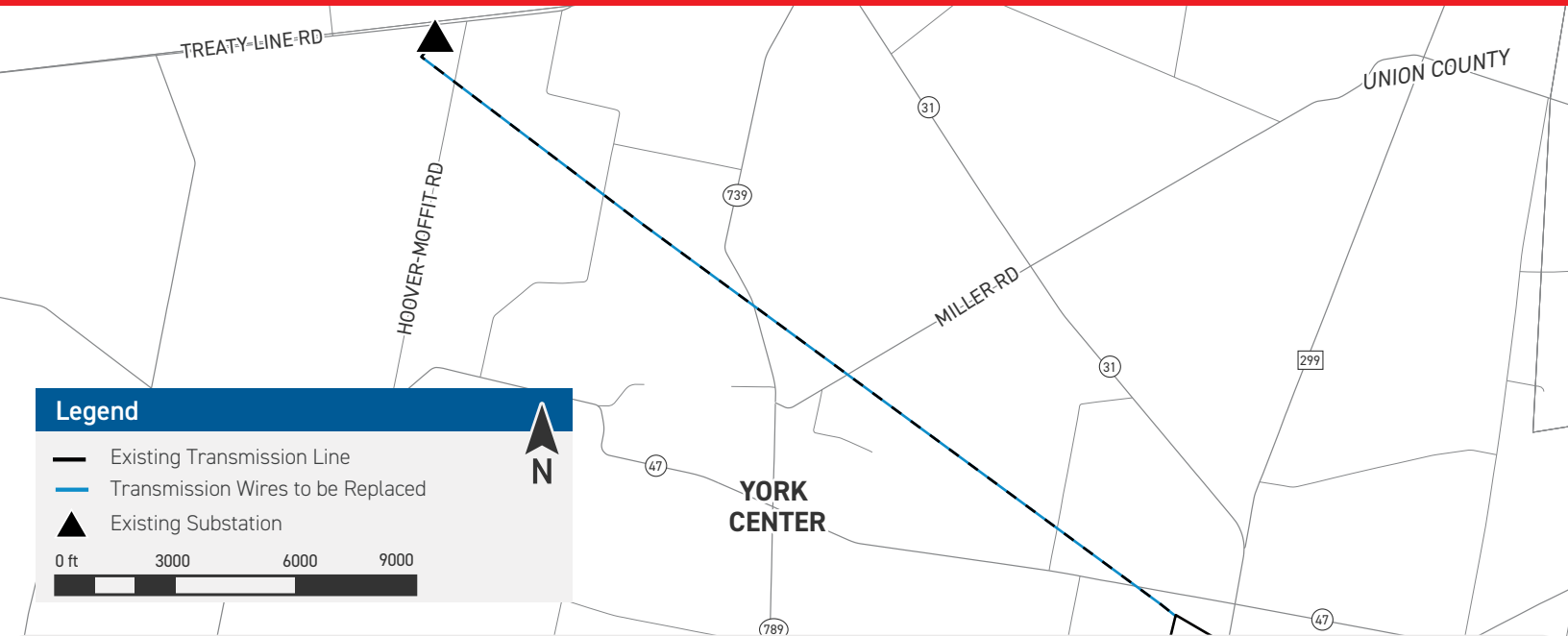
