

NOTICE OF PROPOSED MAJOR UTILITY FACILITY

AEP Ohio representatives are upgrading the power grid in Cranberry Township, Crawford County.

Improvements involve:

- Building Red Run Substation near the intersection of Orr Road and State Route 602.
- Building less than .2 miles of 138-kilvolt (kV) transmission line connecting Red Run Substation to the existing Howard-Fostoria 138-kV transmission line.
- Connecting Red Run Substation to a customer facility.

Company representatives need to build the substation and transmission line to connect a customer to the power grid. If approved, crews plan to start construction this fall and conclude spring 2025.

AEP Ohio representatives have filed the Letter of Notification with the Ohio Power Siting Board (OPSB) as the Red Run Station, Howard-Fostoria 138 kV Cut-in, and Red Run-Sycamore Creek Solar 138 kV Transmission Line Project, Case No. 24-0586-EL-BLN.

The Letter of Notification to construct, operate and maintain this facility awaits OPSB review. The OPSB accepts motions to intervene in the Letter of Notification up to 10 days following the publication date of this notice. The requirements to intervene are included in Rule 4906-2-12 of the Ohio Administrative Code. Please address motions to Ohio Power Siting Board, 180 E. Broad St., Columbus, OH, 43215-3793 and cite Case No. 24-0586-EL-BLN.

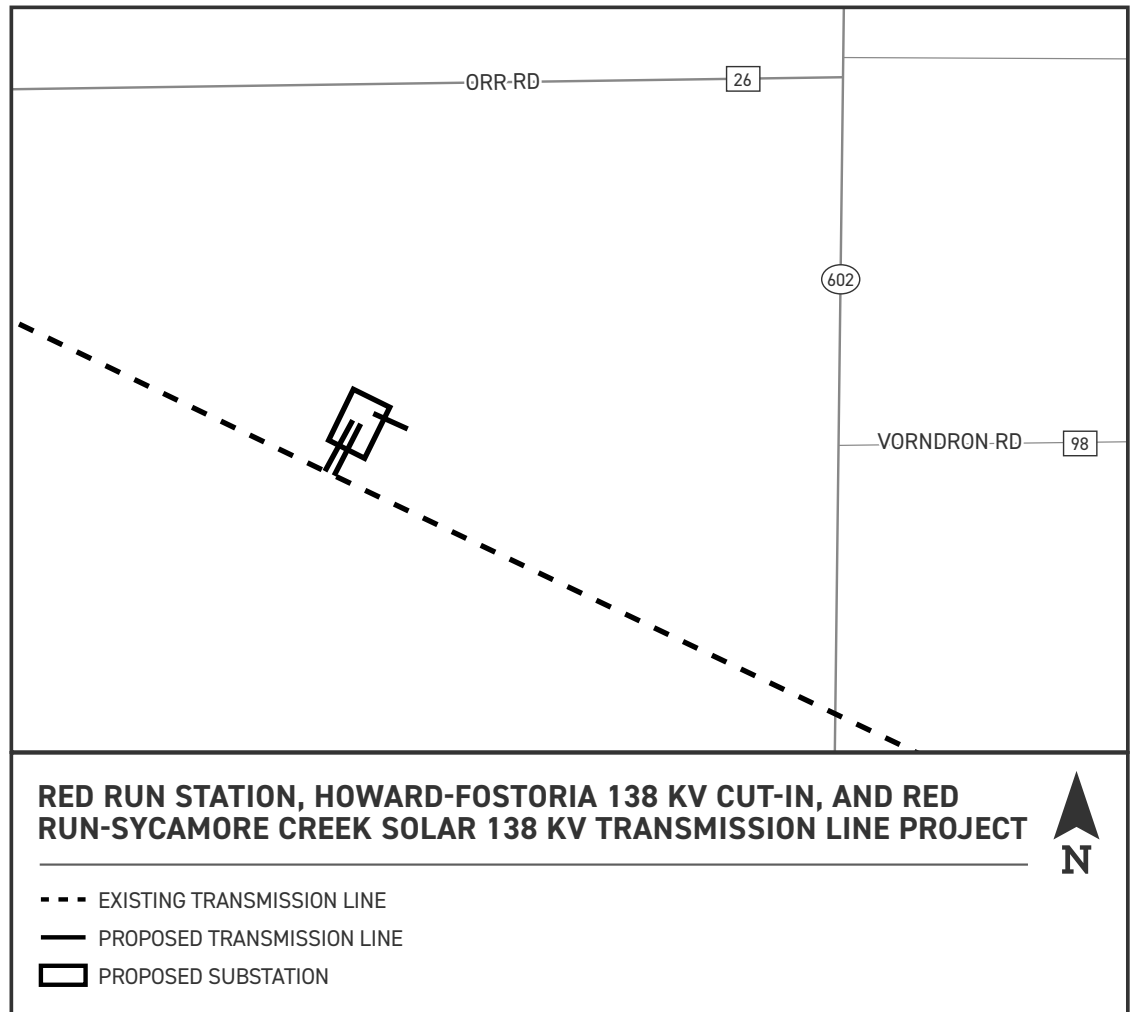
