



WHAT

The project involves:

- Expanding and improving the Stubey Road Substation located near the intersection of Stubey Road and West Chicago Road in Sturgis.
- Building about 9 miles of new 138-kilovolt power line between the Pigeon River Substation located on South Elkhart Street in White Pigeon and the Stubey Road Substation.
- Removing about 9 miles of transmission line between Corey Substation on Cochran Road in Three Rivers and Mottville Substation near Hebron Road in Mottville.


WHY


The improvements:

- Provide additional capacity to the to the electric system to support local economic development.
- Strengthen the local electric transmission system and reduces the likelihood of power outages by adding an additional source of power to the area.
- · Speed recovery of service when outages occur.

WHERE

The upgrades take place in the village of White Pigeon and Sturgis Township in St. Joseph County.






TYPICAL STRUCTURES
