

WHAT

The project involves:

- Replacing wooden poles with steel poles along approximately 58 miles of 138-kilovolt transmission line between the Lon Hill Substation, located off Callicoatte Road and Hearn Road, and the Warburton Substation, located off U.S. Highway 77 South and Warburton Road
- Replacing wires on new and existing poles along the line
- Upgrading equipment at Lon Hill Substation

Project benefits:


- Increases electric capacity to ensure continued electric reliability for customers
- Replaces deteriorating wooden poles from the 1950s with modern equipment to reduce maintenance frequency
- Upgrades to substation equipment reduce the likelihood of larger, sustained community outages
