Three separate energy-related projects are being discussed in Campbell County. Each has its own distinct purpose, owner and approval process.



Joshua Falls 765-kV Substation Relocation Project



Owner: Appalachian Power

What it is:

The Joshua Falls substation, relocated 2.2 miles to accommodate construction of Valley Link, includes **1.5 miles** of new 765-kV line and **2.7 miles** of new 138-kV line for local service.



Approving entities include:

- ✓ PJM Interconnection
- ✓ Virginia State Corporation Commission (SCC)
- ✓ Campbell County



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Joshua Falls to Yeat 765-kV Transmission Line Project



Owner: Valley Link
(Transource, Dominion and FirstEnergy)

What it is:

Valley Link is a regional transmission project intended to strengthen the electric grid and improve reliability across multiple jurisdictions.

Why is the substation being relocated?

Engineering studies determined that expanding the substation at the Joshua Falls location was not practical due to topography, space and cost considerations.

The relocation decision was made independently of the Joshua Falls SMR project.

The Joshua Falls SMR Project is a proposed advanced nuclear energy facility that would generate electricity. The project is currently in early evaluation and site study phases.
